CALL FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

The 2020 IMSSS Symposium seeks to contribute to the new trends in conversion studies by adopting a comparative approach exploring the various modalities of conversion, deconversion, and life passages in Christianity, Judaism, and Islam. **Having completed our Call for Papers, we are now inviting proposals to present posters on any topic relevant to medieval Christian, Jewish, or Muslim preaching, preachers, or sermons.**

The symposium will take place at the Dominican Casa de Espiritualidad y Ejercicios de la Virgen del Camino in León, a city in northwestern Spain. The Dominican presence on that site dates to the 13th century and it is located on the historic pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela.

Please send a poster title, an abstract of 300 words, and an abbreviated CV in English, French, or Spanish to the Organizing Committee at **imsss-2020@upf.edu** by **February 15, 2020**. Applicants will be notified by the end of February. A small number of bursaries will be available for students and young scholars. The Call for bursaries will be published shortly.

Instructions for the elaboration of the posters

The poster session is a tradition of the IMSSS Symposia based on the informal conversation between the attendees and the poster authors on the topics presented. In addition to the usual talk with the attendees, at the beginning of the session there will be a brief presentation of the posters (1-2 minutes per participant).

The languages of the symposium are English and French, and the use of these languages is strongly recommended. However, posters can be presented in Spanish as long as the author can explain to the attendees the contents in English or French.

To avoid large format differences between participants, the organization suggests the following rules for the creation of posters:

Measures (horizontal or vertical): A0 = 1189 x 841 mm. = 33.1 x 46.8 in.
PDF format

The authors will send the poster in PDF format to the e-mail address **imsss-2020@upf.edu** before July 5, 2020. To avoid the inconvenience of transporting the poster, the symposium organization will print the posters. The participants will have to pay the registration fee (40 €) and the printing of the poster (up to, but not more than 20€). For participants who wish to attend the symposium, a full board accommodation will be available at the Casa de Espiritualidad Virgen del Camino de León at the price of 55€ / day.

Instrucciones para la realización de los pósters

La sesión de pósters es una tradición de los simposios de la IMSSS basada en la conversación informal entre los asistentes y los autores de los pósters sobre los temas presentados. Además de la habitual charla con los asistentes, en esta ocasión, al inicio de la sesión habrá una breve presentación de los pósters (1-2 minutos por participante).

Los idiomas del simposio son el inglés y el francés, y se recomienda encarecidamente el uso de estos idiomas. No obstante, se pueden presentar pósters en castellano siempre que el autor/a pueda explicar a los asistentes los contenidos en inglés o francés.

Para evitar grandes diferencias de formato entre participantes, la organización sugiere las siguientes normas para la realización de pósters:

Medida (horizontal o vertical): A0 = 1189 x 841 mm. = 33,1 x 46,8 pulg.

Formato: PDF

Los autores enviarán el póster en formato PDF al correo del simposio imsss-2020@upf.edu antes del 5 de julio de 2020. Para evitar incomodidades en el traslado del póster, la organización del simposio se encarga de la impresión del póster. Los participantes tendrán que abonar la inscripción al congreso (40€), así como la impresión del póster (máximo 20€). Para los participantes que deseen asistir más de un día al simposio, un alojamiento con pensión completa en la Casa de Espiritualidad Virgen del Camino de León estará disponible al precio de 55€/día.
